Continual School Improvement: A Process Approach

Included in the course are elements of a continuous improvement process required for moving from

Title I Targeted Assistance to a Schoolwide Title I program.

WHAT: This year-long online course is designed to engage and support school leaders in developing a continuous improvement process focused on student learning. Specifically, this course gives leaders an organized way to utilize multiple data sources – including the CALL System Survey, school-based tools, and State data – to connect with district goals and create a detailed annual school improvement plan that meets the requirements of Title I.

BENEFITS: can be taken as a non-credit course or for 3 special student academic credits from UW-Madison (applied spring semester).

COST: Non-credit course registration fee: \$450. Participants seeking special student credit pay an additional \$300 (\$100 per credit) prior to the spring semester portion of the course.

REQUIREMENTS: A current CALL license (\$600) for the school you are working with is required for this course. The license can be purchased at https://goo.gl/forms/STvqd8DmZ16CzW6B3.
